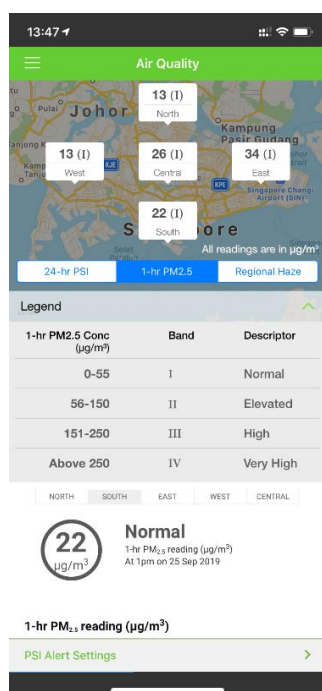


HOLLANDSE CLUB

This is the **only** reference that the Club will use to determine the subsequent safety measures to be taken.

(Please note we do not follow the 24-hr PSI reading as this is an average reading, which does not always relate to the most current haze situation).

SAFETY MEASURES

1-hr PM2.5 Reading 'South'	Action Taken	Area
PM2.5 <70	Club sports activities run as normal.	All
PM2.5 70-90	Club sports activities run at low intensity. Youth Hockey (aged 5-6 years) to relocate to the squash courts (if available).	Tennis Courts Swimming Pools Youth Hockey (Tennis/ Squash Courts)
PM2.5 >90	Club sports activities cancelled. Cancellation recommended to hirers of tennis courts.	Tennis Courts Swimming Pools Squash Courts

PM2.5 >120	Multi-Purpose Court, Tennis Courts, Squash Courts, Swimming Pool closed. All outdoor activities cancelled. No dining on Outdoor Terraces or Camden Courtside.	All areas

CANCELLATION PROCESS

The 1-hour PM2.5 readings will be taken approximately one hour prior to lessons taking place. If the reading **exceeds 90**, Members will be notified as soon as possible by either the Club or Aquaducks (where applicable) via email or WhatsApp that the lesson has been cancelled.

There will be no charges for the late cancellation of court bookings if the PM2.5 is greater than 90.
